<b>Sat Mar 10</b>	VT Team back in Rach Gia Medical Mission Group arrives at Tan Son Nhut Airport Orientation & loading supplies on Cargo truck Dinner & Overnight Sleeper bus to Ca Mau

<b>Fri Mar 16</b>	Last day –Surgery Team discussion with local Team for followup care Medical/Dental Team recommendations to Health Services Farewell Dinner & Overnight Sleeper Bus to Saigon
<b>Sat Mar 17</b>	Check in Hotel early, Breakfast and Free day in Saigon Farewell Party
<b>Sun Mar 18</b>	Departure back to the US

We need health professionals and non-health volunteers to serve children with deformities and eye problems, and rural patients through free operations, medical/dental services and training to medical staff. Registration is open until January 25th with Visa fee due immediately of \$225US. Landcost is due on by February 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$1500 for the 2-week trip and \$900 for the group March 10-18. The Landcost includes transportation, accommodations & meals, and contribution to support services to patients.
